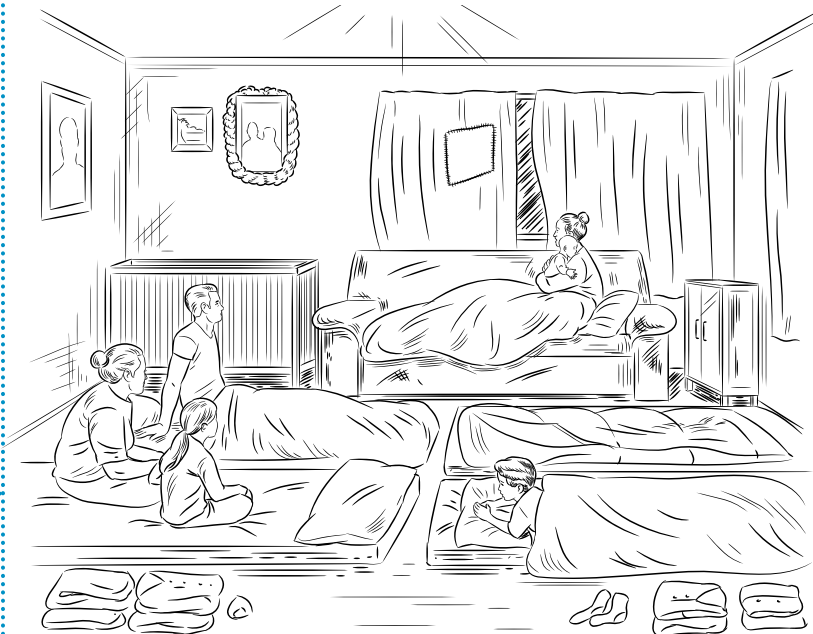


CHILDREN IN LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLDS ARE MORE LIKELY TO LIVE IN CROWDED HOUSING*

ARE MORE LIKELY TO BECOME SICK

MAJOR DAMPNESS
MOULD PROBLEMS
THAN THOSE IN OWNER-OCCUPIED HOMES

THAT LIVE IN 'SOCIAL HOUSING' HAVE A MAJOR PROBLEM
HEATING THEIR HOME IN WINTER

86% of children who regularly
experience being cold are
from households with high
levels of hardship

AT LEAST **13%** OF **KIWI KIDS** LIVE IN **CROWDED HOMES**

Children are considered to live in crowded homes when one or more additional bedrooms are needed for the number of people living in the house and taking into account gender, age and relationships
