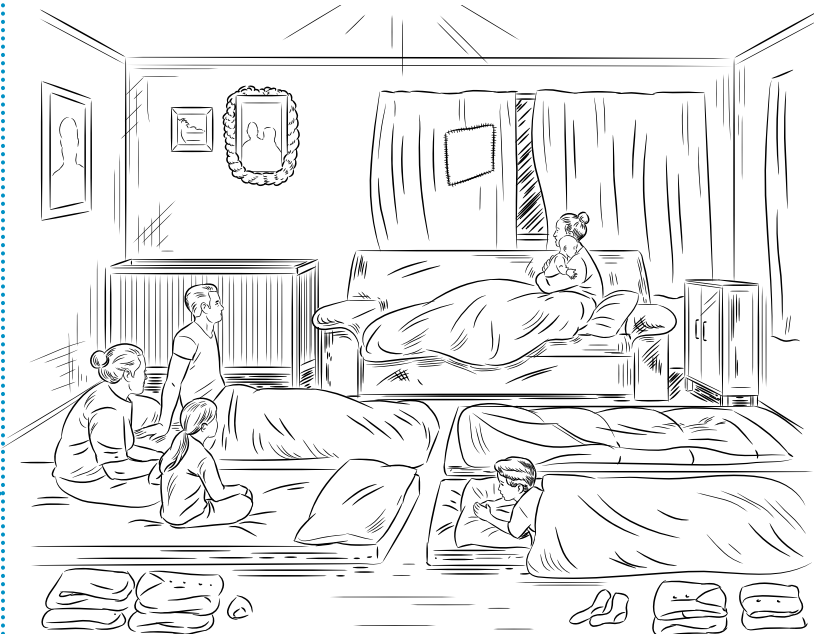


**CHILDREN IN LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLDS ARE MORE LIKELY TO LIVE IN CROWDED HOUSING\***

**38%** OF CHILDREN  
LIVE IN HOUSEHOLDS  
THAT SPEND  
**MORE THAN 30%**  
OF THEIR INCOME ON HOUSING\*



CHILDREN IN COLD, DAMP AND MOULDY HOUSING  
ARE MORE LIKELY TO BECOME SICK

CHILDREN LIVING IN <sup>are</sup> PRIVATE RENTALS **3X**  
MORE LIKELY TO BE IN HOUSES WITH  
**MAJOR DAMPNESS**  
**MOULD PROBLEMS**  
THAN THOSE IN OWNER-OCCUPIED HOMES

**40%** OF CHILDREN IN HOUSEHOLDS  
THAT LIVE IN 'SOCIAL HOUSING' HAVE A MAJOR PROBLEM  
**HEATING THEIR HOME IN WINTER**

**86%** of children who regularly  
experience being cold are  
from households with high  
levels of hardship

AT LEAST **13%** OF **KIWI KIDS** LIVE IN **CROWDED** HOMES

Children are considered to live in crowded homes when one or more additional bedrooms are needed for the number of people living in the house and taking into account gender, age and relationships
